Beaverton Police Seeking Suspect in Fatal Hit-and-Run Incident

Beaverton, Oregon – The Beaverton Police Department is investigating a hit-and-run collision that killed a pedestrian on the evening of October 4, 2025.

At approximately 8:46 PM, a vehicle traveling southbound on Scholls Ferry Road near Hall Boulevard struck a pedestrian and fled the scene.

The victim, 67-year-old Emmanuel Del Cid of Beaverton was pronounced dead at the scene of the crash.

The driver is described as a Latino male in his mid-30s, approximately 5'11" tall, with a medium build, and was last seen wearing a white hoodie.

The suspect vehicle is believed to be a white 2013–2015 Audi A4 or S4, with damage to the front of the car.
