National Police Officers Memorial Week

Beaverton Police Department honors those law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty for the safety and protection of others.

This year's National Police Officers Memorial week is May 13th through May 19th. In 1962, President Kennedy proclaimed May 15th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the calendar week in which May 15th falls, as National Police Week.

The names of 360 fallen officers nationwide were added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC during the 30th annual candlelight vigil on the May 13th.

This week Beaverton Police officers will be wearing morning bands over their badges and non-sworn personnel will wear morning pins crafted by BPD volunteers.
