Rape And Sex Abuse Arrest

On September 19, 2018 Beaverton Police detectives arrested 20-year-old Jonathan Tyler after uncovering evidence that Mr. Tyler had a sexual relationship with a 13-year-old girl and his desire to have a sexual relationship with a 15-year-old girl.

Mr. Tyler, a Salem resident, traveled to Beaverton to meet the 13-year-old victim, for a sexual relationship, on more than one occasion. Mr. Tyler also communicated through a social media application his desire to have a sexual relationship with a 15-year-old girl.

On September 19th Mr. Tyler traveled to Beaverton to meet the 15-year-old victim for sex. Mr. Tyler was arrested by Beaverton Police detectives after arriving at the predetermined meeting location.

On September 25, 2018, evidence in this case was presented to a Washington County Grand Jury. The Grand Jury indicted Mr. Tyler on Rape in the Second degree, Sex Abuse in the First Degree, 2 counts of Online Sexual Corruption of a Minor in the First Degree and 2 counts of Luring a Minor. Mr. Tyler is currently in custody at the Washington County Jail.

Mr. Tyler worked for the Salem-Keizer Education Foundation. Due to Mr. Tyler's work with youth, Beaverton Police detectives believe there may be more victims. Any additional victims are asked to call 503-629-0111 and speak to a Beaverton Police officer.
