Male Arrested With A Drug Selling Business Plan

On April 2, 2019 Beaverton Police officers arrested 31-year-old Erik Mozejko, of Beaverton, for Felon in Possession of Restricted Weapon, Possession of a Controlled Substance (heroin), Delivery of a Controlled Substance (heroin), Possession of a Controlled Substance (methamphetamine), Delivery of a Controlled Substance (methamphetamine), Unlawful possession of a Schedule III drug (suboxone), and two outstanding warrants (Failing to Appear for PCS Heroin/ Reckless Driving/ DUII and Fail to Appear for a traffic offense).

On April 2nd at 11:54 p.m. BPD officers conducted a traffic stop on an unlicensed black Mercedes CLK 350 near SW Allen Blvd/Hwy 217. A drug detection K9 alerted to the odor of drugs within the vehicle. Mozejko was the passenger in the vehicle and had left the area prior to officers locating methamphetamine and heroin under his seat. Other BPD officers located Mozejko a couple of blocks away and took him into custody. A further search of Mozejko and his belongings located more methamphetamine, heroin, money, a scale, syringes, a BB gun, a spring assisted knife, and a drug selling business plan Mozejko had written in his composition notebook.

Mozejko was taken to Washington County Jail and as of this release, is still in custody.
