MURRAYHILL ROBBERIES

Two suspects were arrested early Monday morning, December 23, 2019, at a residence in Tigard, Oregon after three armed robberies were reported in the Murrayhill neighborhood over the weekend. After receiving a tip from a community member, 23-year-old Logan Mathew Grant (pictured below) of Beaverton and a juvenile accomplice (not pictured) were arrested without incident by Beaverton Police officers. Officers seized a pellet gun and other evidence tying the suspects to the robberies. Investigators believe the suspects are responsible for all three robberies.

At 4:34 a.m. on Saturday, December 21, 2019, Beaverton Police responded to Chevron located at 14850 SW Murray Scholls Dr. Employees at Chevron told police they had just been robbed by two masked individuals and one of the individuals displayed a handgun during the robbery.

At 12:01 a.m. on December 22, 2019, a suspect robbed Crumbl Cookies located at 14900 SW Barrows Rd. The suspect, donning a mask to cover their face, displayed a handgun and demanded cash from an employee.

Then again at 10:51 p.m. on December 22, 2019, a pair of suspects robbed Walgreens at 14600 SW Murray Scholls Dr. One of the masked suspects displayed a handgun and demanded cash from a store employee.

The Beaverton Police Department is thankful for an active and engaged community. Investigative tips from the public led to the arrest of the two suspects and the seizure of important evidence.
