POLICE ARE LOOKING FOR A HIT AND RUN SUSPECT

Beaverton, Oregon – A 37-year-old man from Hillsboro was struck by a vehicle and was critically injured on December 19, 2020 while he crossed SW Center St. near SW Hall Blvd. The victim remains in critical condition at local hospital and police are seeking the suspect in the case who fled after the crash.

Investigating officer, Nick Coplin, said around 8:46 PM on December 19, 2020, the light colored, white or silver, sedan (pictured below) with California license plates struck the victim as he crossed SW Center St. in an unmarked crosswalk at SW 125th Ave. After striking the victim, the suspect vehicle continued east on SW Center St. and turned south on SW Lombard Ave.

The suspect vehicle may have damage to the front bumper or quarter panel on the passenger side where it struck the victim.
