### **Public Notice – 2022 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Application**

The Beaverton Police Department is submitting a grant application through the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program (Local Solicitation) through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice.

The Police Department plans to use \$25,829 in available funds to support four projects:

- Computer and camera equipment for community engagement and digital media marketing - \$10,000
- In-car video camera systems for two custody transport vans - \$6,354
- Traffic safety investigation equipment (crash data recorder “black box” computer equipment) - \$4,475
- Safety equipment for patrol (three replacement ballistic shields for patrol sergeant vehicles)- \$5,000
