Alan Juilfs Sworn In as Deputy Chief

Chief Stacy Jepson has appointed 21-year-veteran Alan Juilfs as Beaverton Police Department's new Deputy Chief. Alan Juilfs brings an array of experience and talent to this role. He spent 10 years as a patrol officer and held specialty roles in Field Training, the Mobile Response Team and as a lead firearms instructor. He was promoted to sergeant in 2011 and worked in patrol until he became the Training Division sergeant in 2014. During his time in the Training Division, he was responsible for overseeing Field Training, In-Service Training, and managed the department's firearms.

In 2019, Alan Juilfs became a lieutenant and served in the Patrol Division. In addition to his patrol shift responsibilities, he oversaw the Interagency Tactical Negotiations Team, Crisis Negotiations Unit, Mental Health Response Team, Peer Support Program and was the BPD liaison for both the Washington County Family Justice Center and the City of Beaverton's Emergency Management department. He has been serving the past 16 months as captain managing the Services Division of BPD including Police Records, Community Services, and the administrative functions of the department. In September after a departmental reorganization, he also took Training and Logistics under his division.

Deputy Chief Juilfs uniquely holds a BS in Wildlife Biology from Oregon State University with an emphasis in natural resources management. He is a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigation Law Enforcement Executive Development Association trilogy and holds an Executive Certification from DPSST. In 2016, he was deployed to Bangladesh as a member of the Law Enforcement Partnership Team with U.S. Department of Justice. In Bangladesh, he taught basic officer safety and survival at their National Police Academy in Sardah.

Alan Juilfs was sworn in as Deputy Chief at 6:00 PM on December 19, 2022, at the Beaverton Public Safety Center.
