The Armed Forces Banner Program was initiated by the city of Beaverton to honor and recognize Beaverton's military personnel. The program began with seed money from the city, however its long-term success will depend upon community support through business donations and sponsorships. The number of applications approved for banners will be limited by the availability of funds. To qualify, honorees must meet the following requirements:

- Active duty military personnel of the United States Armed Forces. Include reservists and Guard Personnel who are called to an active duty status and deployed for six or more consecutive months. Request must be made and approved during that six month or more deployment.
- Honoree or requester must be a current resident of the Beaverton School District attendance area.
