Beaverton Honors Active Duty Military Personnel

The city of Beaverton honors active duty military personnel with colorful patriotic banners displayed at specific locations in the city.

Who qualifies?

Any active duty military person or if the military person has a relative who lives within the boundaries of Beaverton can apply.

How does a person apply?

An application can be accessed on-line by going to the banner website at www.beavertonoregon.gov/MilitaryBannerProgram. Print the application, fill it out and send to Armed Forces Banner Program, PO Box 4755, Beaverton, OR 97076 or fax to 503-526-2484.

What is the cost?

Due to generous donations from the city of Beaverton and corporations within the city, the banners are no cost to the recipient as long as the program can be funded through those donations.

What happens after the application is submitted?

If the application meets the program requirements, a banner is ordered. The applicant will be notified of the location, date and time of the display.

How long is the banner displayed?

It will be displayed on a city street light pole (initially started on SW Murray Blvd south of SW Allen) for a maximum of one year or at the recipient's honorable separation from service. The banner will then be retired and given to the recipient or family member at a Beaverton city council meeting.
